You may receive additional savings by selecting a dentist from the Maximum Care Dental Network. This network provides access to dentists nationwide who offer discounted services. Even if you choose a dentist who isn't in the network to perform your covered dental procedure, you'll still receive the same benefit amounts.

Optional riders

For an added cost, you may have the option of purchasing additional riders for even greater financial protection. Talk with your benefits counselor to learn more about these riders.

- Orthodontic benefit rider This rider provides \$500 for the initial orthodontic treatment. After the initial treatment, this rider provides \$50 for treatment involving a covered orthodontic procedure. There is a maximum payment of one treatment per month for up to 18 treatments and a lifetime maximum of \$1,400 payable per covered person. There is a 24-month waiting period.
- **Vision rider** This rider provides a \$50 benefit for an eye exam and \$50 for vision correction materials. Maximum of one benefit for eye exam and one benefit for vision correction materials per covered person per calendar year. There is a 30-day waiting period.

WAITING PERIODS
